Canyon de Chelly National Monument Begins Road Project

Canyon de Chelly National Monument will begin Pavement Preservation Work along the South Rim and the North Rim Spur Roads including parking lots at each overlook and the visitor center. The road work will rehabilitate and improve roads as well as improve safety for all thru traffic within the park. The first phases of construction will begin around the week of July 31, 2017 and traffic control will be in place throughout the entire project.

The road construction may cause some areas to be inaccessible for a period of time and motorists can expect delays while work is in progress. We ask that you be patient while these improvements are being conducted and we apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. For your safety and the safety of the work crew, the park asks that you please **Do Not Enter** the construction areas.
