IX. Reports:

a. Chapter President Rosanna Jumbo-Fitch:

As far as my report we did have a Work session on Friday, February 26, which involved myself, our Vice President Shawna Claw, our Secretary/Treasurer Roann Burbank, Our Grazing Rep. Oscar Bia, as well as our Delegate Honorable Eugene Tso, and his LDA Joann Dedman, and we also worked with our Chinle Chapter Administration Walton Yazzie, Tyrone Begay, Ilene Thomas, Tamara Brown and also the staff that were on site. We di review a lot of documents. We spent the entire day from 8 am to about almost 4pm, reviewing the documents presented in the New Business. We reviewed line by line, discussed any questions, comments, and we implemented new policy

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and procedures that we saw that were important within our Chinle Chapter community and we have also again are waiting on our local Department of Justice chapter unit representative to provide some more input as far as the Chapter unit to provide us more input as far as heavy equipment. As you are all aware, we did get approval to purchase new heavy equipment, such as a motor grader, backhoe, and so were waiting for updates on that aspect in order to implement that into our policy and procedures. So, that is why it is not an action item that we are proposing for this mouth but we do want to keep our community polated as far as what we ar working on, and overall we reviewed and reflected out project list. We had a huge list of 22 projects and we reviewed the past three years of resolutions and recommendations from previous chapter off ials and so, we really went trough line items and checked project prorities, costs, location as well as other community representatives the could be involved in our projects. We also worked differtly on eviewing each of the committee Box CLUPS as we as Make Chinle Yours and reviewing the plan of operations well/as the committee goals and objectives, so the why we cade the surrent recommendations today, and that's what we been doing this past week at least and that is my eport for this planning meeting. If there are no questions, we are going to so of down, again we are going to move straight into our administrative start Mr. Walton Yazzie. We did have some information to update as far as the budget compliance. SO the floor is yours.

#### b. Administrative Staff:

Chapter Manager Walton Yazzie:

President Rosanna: Yeah, you know like the monthly compliance so that way we have an updated report for this meeting. So, I know it's a lot of information but if you can go through it again. Just like what we did at the last planning meeting.

CM Walton: Presents the Financial Report, Summary Reconcile and accounts for February.

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President Rosanna: Thank you Walton. I'm sure we will have some homework this week to review those items, but we appreciate your report. Are there any questions? Okay. Theres a lot of numbers. Next, we are going to move down our reports list. We have discussed how everybody else wait until next chapter meeting. So, next item is going to be (g) The Richfield

Delegate Eugene Tso: Madam Chair, Eugene Tso

President Rosanna; Yes

Delegate Tso so I guess I was muce so, I am sorry to interrupt. I was trying to ge some answers here. I know Walton speaks quick in the Navajo, so I am going to ask him in Navajo. This Legislation going into process, its going to be on the special session on Thursday, that 0017 That one, in there added \$101 housand, added onto \$25,000, that gives us the total. But now I think heard \$117, I think I heard, I don't know if you said that but I musking if its \$117; and also, did you say also that you got back that \$1.0,000 from that PAE from the people pat are running the Community Center? Is that what you said as well so can you explain that because, there on the floor, I'm going to be grouned. I want all the chapters is going to be questioned because in the hole, in the negative. They are going to question us; what for, if there is something you can back me up with. It would be really not. What you reported, I would like a report. Madam Chair my doughter.

President Rosanna: Aheehe, my father. Walton can you answer those two questions?

CM Walton: Yes, PAE is a contract that we have from the beginning to have (10) employees to work at the CCC. So, that's nothing to do with our regular budget they usually give us the money back as quickly as possible, but we're having a glitch because we had a different computer where we draw money, we had to get our computer updated. So, it wasn't working and we re-entered it and got it. So, that's really, the Chapter doesn't really pay anything thats 100% reimbursable. So, they didn't pay us back, that's why it was in the negative. That has nothing to do with the Emergency side. So, that's

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just another contract we have. So, that should be the Nation does not deny to give us that money. On this one, Mr. Tso, this one here your referring to, Emergency Fund is shown, this what it is right now. Back in November, remember," its okay, go ahead" they said, ASC and DCD, your employees making bathroom additions was approved, as long as you do a pre-cost. So, Dine, they started working. We started working on bathroom additions. We hired 20 people to do bathroom additions, and at the leaf Arenember, when they done the final decision, "No", they said. They said "no more", so that's why that salary it's n negative \$31,973.49. That was a all the bathroom addition crew, that was working out there to use that chair fund, that's what was for Then, the vehicle mileage, that we deliver to other Chapters we are the Point of Distursement, here. From here, they call us from the command center that things for the other Chapters, we wife old. So, that was the plan or operation with them. So, it's not free the gas is not free you know arriving down there and taking (5) vehicle out there, and len returning it pretty low, bring it here and that we look to deliver to the Chapters, this is how much goes to Pinor Chapter, how pages to Cottonwood Chapter, said we spread it back out and ve deliver it. That is why our gas price is pretty high, in the negative \$16.25004. Then, the Chapter food recount. We had a lot of positive patients from the beginning. Remember, this that Council Delegate, theres a lot of Council Delegates text me. You guys probably remember Mrs. Gorman from Many Farms, remember she is always on the radio. I forgot, I think her name is Rita. She really got mad at us about the Chapter not helping out positive patients. Our old Officials and us, were trying to say that this money is actually for our Chapter orders that get positive pieces or something to help the system but, we were told by the, your Madam, the one that voted no the first time, what was her name, one of the Delegate lady. She's the one that text me personally saying that. you know, the Chapter shouldn't be denying people if they're positive you need to get them food, supplies and get them going, they sold us, and that's how we went into the negative. Buying supplies for these

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positive cases. And Then, Repair Maintenance, you know all of you people, oil change when we deliver. I know my new Officials really question that too. We do our maintenance, we do our oil change, our tire rotations, sometimes our tires pop because we really didn't have funds or money to buy a certain things, but at this case we're always using those vehicles. Cleaning them, oil change, we have actually done maintenance on them, and that's what happen. We went into negative \$5,700.00 hr. the negative \$29,000 and that our backhoe. Our backhoe is still down. You know that the Chine Chapter was the only one open. So, we were doing 17 burials week, all over the Chinle Agency because there was no backho available and all the Chapters were closed. We had a lot of death verywhere. We had scheduled a backhoe service in the morning, and in the afternoon, in the evenings, weekends. So, our backhee really took a beating. So we did inform them that, and the Navajo Nation Nesident done a News Release saying that no Chapter should be charge for burials, the papters are there to be, remember they done in Face book five, DGD letter to as saying that you guys better no say "No you guys are POD, you guys heed to get men burnals done, and then DCD said that they were going to help, but their backhes went down, and also their workers, they said are temporary so they're not allowed to work weekends or after hours. So, we at the Chinle Chapter is the one that done all the cost and that for burials. So, we did, and that's the reason why there a lot of maintenance on these things. We had to get it refurbished every single time that we utilize it, so, that's why were in the negative. Repair and Others is just a little, that's how the money went into the negative. We were told by DCD since we're POD, that the Chinle Chapter will get funds. You guys just keep your cost, and we will fight for you to get funds, they told us. So, from the beginning, that's what we believed in and what we trusted in. I believe Dr. Yellowman been trying to ask the Delegates. She informed us, we did reach out the President's Office, asking them that they, you guys are the one that put us at liable for it. We were put on Facebook, we

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got blasted for it, because we were trying to say that, you know we're going into the negatives, we can't do burials, we're not allowed. Now, our backhoe is down so Nazlini has been assisting us when we need to. But now, we made an agreement with the Apache County, so the understand our backhoe is down and have been really helping us. But they do charge a fee over there also for \$50.00 and they can only do on certain days. So, we're trying to work it out. So, thats how this whole thing went into a negative, and I know the majority of the Council Delega es understand, because they did text me personally, and told me I should not be saying no because its an emergency, you guys get a done, your people meeds it, was told. So, we had an impression that DCD give us that money back along time ago its been den't know if you guys have you other questions or anything Delegate Engelie Tso: Madam Chai? Okam money maybe. My question is that \$104 thousand, that did you said was given back to you? That was, or question. And where did you get it, that one. Also, the other one is report you want I would like to see that, I mean I don't have any stions of my all this and that, its just my colleague over there, when they entertion, and everybody can understand what happened, how it hopened, that it be known, if I could have it is writing to justify it. But again too. This amendment, I'm going to put I was m king, they already add it on to the \$25,000. So, its included as is, that way, so, that's how it is added. So, that is that way. So, if they're going to ask each of Chapter to verify it, to justify it, right there I would need some kind of document. That I am asking for. I understand what you are talking about, I understand the hardship out there, that I know, I have been there for so long. I made 32 yrs., among the people, so that is how I know. So, that's the reason why I ask for it, certain things I do, I ask money for the whole Navajo Nation. That is that way. So, assists us there. Document, meaning that the \$104 you speak of, how do you mean. Was it given back to you, did you get it back already, did you say? And then, I think DCD got paid, too, for medical, for those that are being care for. The Tribe paid

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them back. Working it out with Mr., the Superintendent, Quincy, my brother

This is grant the dormitory to be in operation from July 1st, 2021 to June 30th, 2025. So, we are in a grant status. So, we have to go through reauthorization with the Navajo Tribe, and so we're getting our packet together. So, I'm asking for a resolution from the Chapters to continue to operate and dormitory for students. So, I am asking for your help with that. This packet will be submitted to Navajo Nation March 15th of this year. So, well be turning in the packet. IN education, you know, where there reauthorization process. We have a place, and so that is what I am asking for at this time. Thank you.

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Rosanna: Miss Lewis, Do you have any demographics from your Chinle population for student that have been in attendance in your dormitory that you could you can also share with us? Lorna: Yeah, I think there was (9). There, I kind of lost it in my email, here. I can't find it. When your system was down, I was trying to refer to my phone and I had it set on my phone, now I cant even find that information in here. So, I think there was (9) students from there with address from Chinle and ... Lets see where is it... well I cant find it. These things er messed up and it hesses up everything.
