- a. Sharon Yazzie: had a community concern about the Wood for Life. She explained that the wood is received through a grant and going through trial/error. Wood applications need a voter verification, a second person should the applicant cannot pick wood. Eight (8) loads are given to and elders are first. Sharon explained that cards are given for the wood and it is not open when the No Wood sign is out. The wood is free. Sharon expressed to the membership that speaking badly, and name calling would cause the free wood to close. The workers work in the heat 9-10 hrs. a day with chainsaws, and log splitters. Sharon Explained that there are is a closure of the wood due to the budget and few employees to help with the wood. Sharon asks the chapter to be kind to the workers.
- b. Dorcen Bia: had a concern about the congested lot that used to be Smith's Café. Chapter President Rosanna Jumbo-Fitch: explained that it belongs to RBDO and not the chapter and are aware of it however they will follow up with RBDO.

Oscar states that we create chaos for ourselves and for our family. Oscar also explained that there are no irrigations for planting because there is no one to do it. Oscar talked about the business site leases for tours and that they are not allowed to use the vehicles for personal travel.

e. Honorable Delegate Shawna Ann Claw

Delegate Shawna Ann Claw: Submitted a report and is on file. Delegate Claw talked about NNC funding meeting from which she came resulted in a hybrid resolution, not a continuing resolution for the budget. Delegate Claw explained the previous budgets were for 6 months and had to be renegotiated. Buu Nygren will sign the Hybrid resolution. Delegate Shawna Ann Claw talked about the UUFB and the CVPUA to get and amendment for his legislation. Delegate Claw asked for Johnson Claw's proposal.
