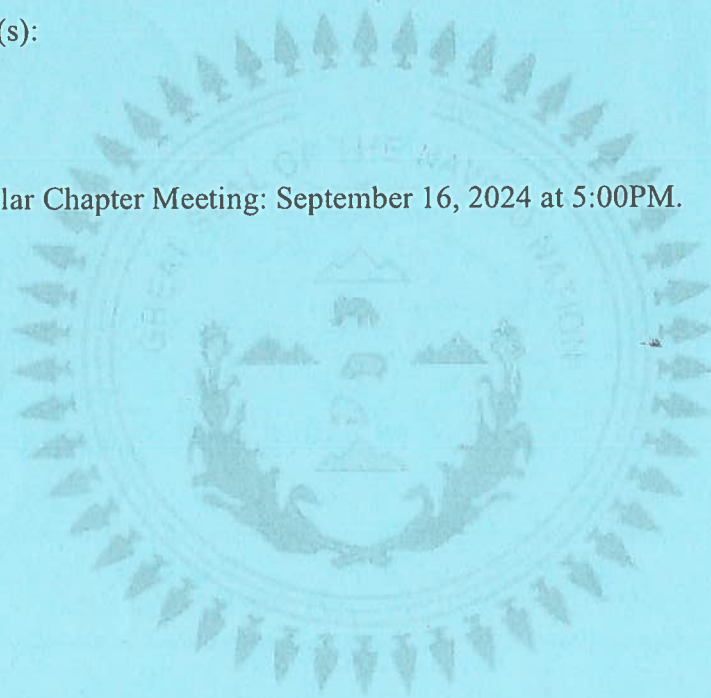

She was informed that the Chinle Chapter Government would be taking over the RV Park when the project is completed. She was informed that there were several community meeting over that and if could leave her contact information they will reach out to her because CCG has nothing to do with that project and that it is NTUA.

- e. **Jameline Jim:** requested for a Homesite lease ½ mile south of Holiday Inn. She will be working with Grazing Official Oscar Bia Sr. to complete her Home site lease.
- f. **Tiara Francis** is on the community concerns because she is an attendee of NTU and she is participating in a project that addresses behavior and some are hostile at meetings, use of harsh wording and the lack of compassion during communications.
- g. **Leander Staley:** requested to be on the Community concerns to request for a road in Canyon De Chelly for entry and egress for farming and also requests for culvert, and request for support for Spider Rock road.
- h. **Sharon Yazzie:** requested to be on the Community Concerns for the firewood program. She states that when community is given something for free voters tend to ruin it by cussing, name calling and abusive behavior. She requests the community to be patient and treat works right.
